Points Raised by the President of the Federation:

1. Rakholi Bridge Status:

- The President highlighted the critical importance of the Rakholi bridge for the industry and requested an update on its status.

2. Samarvani to Masat Road Condition:

- The poor condition of the Samarvani to Masat road was discussed, with an emphasis on the need for urgent repairs.

3. Provision of Drinking Water for Industries:

- The President raised concerns about the availability and quality of drinking water for industries in the region.

4. Use of Ground Surface Water by Industries:

- The issue of allowing industries to use ground surface water was brought up for consideration.

Collector's Response:

1. Rakholi Bridge Status:

- The Collector informed that two agencies had observed a lack of strength in the bridge.

- A new investigation report is expected by Saturday, after which further actions will be decided.

- If strength issues persist, some relaxation may be provided for industrial and local buses, and a new circular will be issued based on the agency's report.

- Additional traffic police officers will be deployed to manage traffic on both sides of the bridge.

2. Samarvani to Masat Road Condition:

- The Collector ordered SMC officials to fill potholes on this route, with an expected completion time of 3-4 days, weather permitting.

- It was also mentioned that the Dokmandi Bridge will be opened for regular traffic within 10-15 days.

3. Provision of Drinking Water for Industries:

- The Collector acknowledged the concern and assured that steps would be taken to address the issue.

4. Use of Ground Surface Water by Industries:

- The Collector noted the request and stated that it would be considered in future planning.

Additional Discussions:

- The Collector emphasized the importance of adhering to fire and safety norms in industrial areas and announced that inspections led by his team would commence within a month.

- The Collector urged industries to contribute to the collective CSR fund to settle outstanding amounts for the GAWSHALLA.

Conclusion:

- The meeting concluded with the Collector ensuring that all raised issues would be addressed promptly and efficiently.
